This new facility strengthens neurological diagnostic capacity and supports clinical evaluation for brain, nerve, and muscle-related conditions. By expanding diagnostic services within the hospital system, IITH continues to bring specialized care closer to patients in Sialkot and surrounding regions.



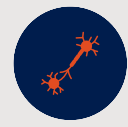

Advanced Hepatobiliary Surgery

Advanced Hepatobiliary Surgery was introduced at Imran Idrees Teaching Hospital (IITH) under the expertise of **Dr. Hafiz Bilal Ahmed**, marking continued growth in specialist surgical services. Hepatobiliary care focuses on diseases of the liver, gallbladder, bile ducts, and pancreas, requiring expert evaluation, precise surgical planning, and comprehensive hospital-based care.

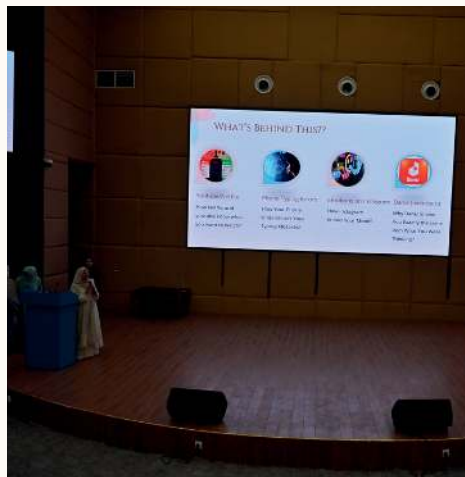
